Recreational Activities

Wednesday Morning - Kids Activity

Planned for the first morning in Vail during the Spouses' Book Club. Several options are offered; <u>pick only one activity for each child participating</u>. These activities all take place concurrently.

✓ "Kids Kamp" – \$30 per child (could be less depending on final price quote from the hotel).

For kids under age six, the "Kids Kamp" will take place in the hotel's childcare area with a hotel staff member. Games, crafts and other fun activities.

The following activities will take place at Vail's Adventure Ridge facility located at the top of the Eagle Bahn Gondola. Prices quoted below include the gondola ride. All participants will be escorted up the mountain by an AESC staff person. Depart the hotel at 9:30 a.m., return at approximately 12 noon.

- ✓ Kids Action Pass \$32 per child. For ages 6 12. Participate in three of the following activities: pony ride; harnessed trampoline; climbing wall; disc golf.
- ✓ Horseback Trour \$87 per rider (there is a limited of 10 participants) Suitable for ages 7 and up. Take a scenic horseback tour from Eagle's Nest through Game Creek Bowl and back, overlooking the Vail Valley.
- ✓ Rope's Course \$66 per participant. For ages 10 and up, at least 52" tall and more than 40 lbs. Choose your own adventure with one of Vail Mountain's High Ropes Challenge Courses. Put your navigation abilities to the test when you traverse through obstacles while high in the air.

Thursday Afternoon - AESC Tennis Tournament

Our annual tennis tournament will take place at the Cascade Athletic Club courts. Round robin play assures everybody plenty of court time. We will have two indoor and two outdoor courts. Demo racquets are available to rent for \$5. Registration fee includes tennis balls and beverages.
