FACTS Jackson River Tubing Float Trip

Day: Wednesday, August 4th

Time: 1:15 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Meet at the front door the hotel at 1:15 p.m. We have a bus that will take our entire group to the put-in point on the river. It will be about 2 hours on the river with expected return to the hotel at about 5:30 p.m.

Suggest each person bring the following:

- Water bottle (preferably with wrist strap)
- Water shoes, waterproof sandals with straps, flip flops. Note the area between the parking lot to the put-in point is rocky
- Sunglasses (recommend straps)
- Hat
- Sunscreen
- And of course... swimwear (bathing suit, cut-offs) and a t-shirt if you wish

The outfitter will provide:

- Life jackets
- Small water bottle at the half-way point and granola bars
- And the river!

The Jackson River is a major tributary of the James River flowing a total of 96 miles. River levels are dictated by releases from the Gathright Dam located 18.5 miles upstream at Lake Moomaw. This will be a guided float trip... no whitewater! Each floater (retina doctors take note!) will have their own tube.
