Finders Keepers

Let the hunt begin! Discover glass treasures on the beach only in Lincoln City during this defining program. Year-round, our "Float Faires" covertly hit our seven miles of public beach hiding thousands of handcrafted glass floats along their way, from Roads End to Siletz Bay. You find it, you keep it.

Throughout the year, special drops take place where extra floats are hidden in addition to normal daily drops. Special drops often happen over select holiday weekends or other times of the year such as spring break. Check out ExploreLincolnCity.com for specific dates.

The Basic Rules of the Hunt

- Floats can be found above the high tide line and below the beach embankment.
- Floats are placed on the beach during daylight hours only, and are hidden throughout the day, not just at one time.
- Floats are hidden every day, year-round.
- Floats go out rain or shine, extreme conditions permitting.
- One float per person, per year.

A Few Tips

We use the term "hide" loosely, most floats are found on the same day they are hidden. Start your hunt at a public beach access. Float Faires have to get down on the beach too and they will often use the same access points as you do. Floats are hidden at random times and locations...no one knows exactly when or where floats will be dropped during the day. Floats will always be placed on the public parts of the beach, never on private property.

Be mindful of fragile ecosystems while hunting for treasure. Carefully explore areas near tidepools, protect beach grass and other vegetation and enjoy wildlife with your eyes only.

Register Your Float

When you find a float, register it to receive a Certificate of Authenticity and an artist bio. Floats can be registered online at ExploreLincolnCity.com, by calling 541-996-1274, at our Visitor Information Center or via text message. Instructions are attached to each float.

Take a Hike

Cascade Head: The Nature Conservancy Interpretive Trail is two miles long and moderately difficult. The southern view of the coast and Salmon River Estuary is spectacular. Take Three Rocks Road north of Lincoln City to Knight Park. The trailhead is a short walk away. Looking for more? Explore Harts Cove just to the north.

Drift Creek Falls: Accessible north of Lincoln City via Hwy 18 or south by Drift Creek Road, this 3-mile out and back hike features a 240-foot suspension bridge with superb views of the falls. This moderate hike is in a day use fee area with on-site parking available.

The Knoll: A moderately difficult 1.5-mile uphill hike, rewarded by gorgeous views of the Pacific Ocean and southern coastline. Head north on NE Devils Lake Blvd from Hwy 101. Follow the road until you reach a cul-de-sac. Park on the street, and the trailhead is just beyond the road.

Open Spaces

Open spaces feature landscapes of forests, wetlands, and hidden havens that are essential to ecosystem health in the area. Sitka spruce, coastal flora and coho salmon all make their homes in these diverse areas of Lincoln City, along with secluded hiking trails to explore, many in the heart of the city.

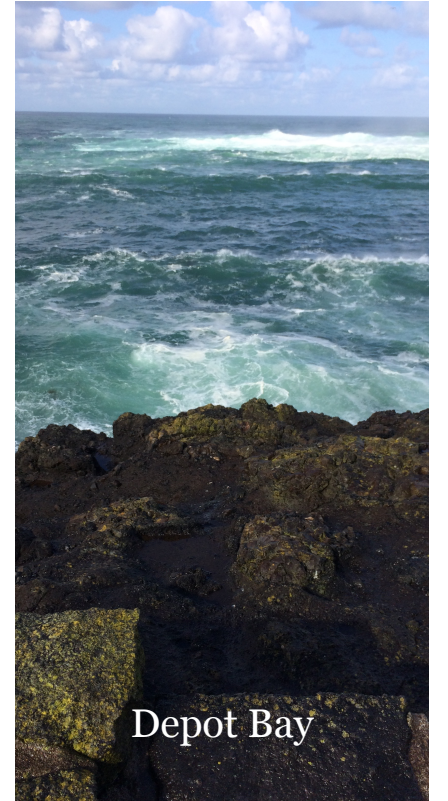


Beach walking fun:
